**MOTION FOR A CONTINUANCE FOR PARTIES TO FILE THEIR PRE-
TRIAL ORDER**

NOW COMES the Taxpayer by and through its attorney, Al Giudice, moves this Tribunal for an order granting the parties a continuance to file their pre-trial order. In support of this Motion, the parties state as follows:

1. On April 1, 2015, the Tribunal issued an order to the parties to:1) “submit a proposed pre-trial order by June 30, 2015” and 2) scheduled a status conference for July 14, 2015 at 9:30 a.m in order to prepare a final pretrial order and set a hearing date.
2. Taxpayer’s counsel was out of the office from April 2- 10, 2015 and again June 14-22, 2015.
3. The Taxpayer discussed the proposed pretrial order with Counsel for the Department on June 24, 2015 and both parties believe that a short extension is essential in order to make the factual issues within the pre-trial order as helpful and succinct as possible.
4. Therefore, the Taxpayer respectfully request a continuance until July 31, 2015 to allow the parties to complete the proposed pre-trial order in as helpful and succinct a manner as possible for the Tribunal.

5. Thereafter, the Taxpayer requests that a status conference be held at the Tribunal's convenience.

6. By allowing the parties this extension, neither party will be prejudiced.

7. This Motion is made in good faith.

WHEREFORE, the parties respectfully request that an order be entered (1) granting the parties leave to file its proposed pre-trial order on July 31, 2015; (2) allowing a status hearing thereafter; and (3) for such other relief as this Court deems just and proper.
