POST-HEARING ORDER

The parties appearing today before the Tribunal for an in-person hearing and presenting testimony and documentary evidence, it is ORDERED that:

1. the record will kept open for the submission of post-hearing briefs which should address the law and facts governing the use of the “Midwest average” used to estimate gasoline sales and the law and facts governing imposition of the fraud penalty, in addition to whatever other issues the parties wish to address;
2. after further consideration, the denial of Petitioner’s request to admit the exhibits first offered at today’s hearing is REVERSED to the extent that the parties may address the admissibility and effect of those exhibits in their post-hearing briefs; and;
3. the Tribunal will provide the parties with notice of completion of the transcript of proceedings, and each party will make its own arrangements for obtaining a copy of the transcript.
