ORDER

The petition in this matter is not accepted by the Tribunal.

The Petition is signed by a corporate officer. The Illinois Code of Civil Procedure and Illinois Supreme Court Rules do not provide for corporations to appear on behalf of themselves, with the exception of appearing in small claims cases. 735 ILCS 5/2-416; Ill. Sup. Ct. R. 282. Pursuant to Sections 5000.305(a)(1),(2) and (3) of the Tribunal's Rules, a taxpayer, other than an individual appearing *pro-se*, must be represented by an attorney authorized to practice law in the State of Illinois or by an attorney who has followed the procedures to appear *pro hac vice* in Illinois. The attorney needs to sign the Petition. Tax Tribunal Rule 5000.310(a)(1)(H).

The Petitioner will have 30 days to file a corrected petition or this matter will be dismissed. The filing fee will be returned by mail.
