## **Scheduling Order**

interrogatories for each additional Count, not including Counts related solely to

imposition of penalties or interest;

telephone;

4. Notices of deposition shall be served by December 31, 2017;

5. All motions relating to discovery shall be filed on or before February 28, 2018;

6. Discovery shall be completed, and will close, on or before April 13, 2018;

7. A joint request for final pre-hearing mediation may be made on or before May 18,

2018;

8. If mediation is not requested, initial dispositive motions will be filed by June 15,

2018; and

9. If dispositive motions are filed, a briefing schedule for responses and replies will

be set, or if the parties do not file dispositive motions, the matter will be set for a

final pretrial conference at a status conference on June 21, 2018 at 9:30 a.m. by

telephone.
