ORDER

On November 5, 2014, this Court set a status conference in this matter for January 7, 2015. Mr. McNeil was ordered to appear in person on January 7, 2015 if he had not produced certain records to the Department and was otherwise ordered to attend the status conference by telephone if he had produced the records.

On January 7, 2015, Mr. McNeil did not appear in person and the Tribunal was unable to reach him by telephone. The Tribunal set another status conference for January 15, 2015 to be attended by the parties by telephone. Once again, the Court was unable to contact Mr. McNeil by telephone on January 15, 2015. Another status conference for January 21, 2015, to be attended by Mr. McNeil in person, was set by this Court.

On January 21, 2015, Mr. McNeil failed to appear in person for the scheduled status conference at the Tribunal.

Mr. McNeil has ignored three separate orders of the Tribunal and has failed to appear in person or by telephone as ordered by this Court. Mr. McNeil was

admonished in the court order dated January 15, 2015 that his failure to appear in person on January 21, 2015 would result in the dismissal of this case.

It is hereby ORDERED:

1. This case is dismissed with prejudice.
