ORDER

The petition in this matter has been accepted by the Tribunal and the Department is to file its answer on or before May 16, 2014. The initial status conference is set for June 4, 2014 at 9:45 a.m.

At the initial status conference, the parties should be prepared to discuss: 1) the nature of the case; 2) factual and legal issues; 3) settlement potential and discussions to date; 4) anticipated discovery; and 5) potential motions to be filed.

Because counsel for the Petitioner is in Peoria, the initial status conference will be held via telephone conference. The Tribunal will call both parties on the date and at the time set.

Counsel for Petitioner is directed the Petitions page on the Tribunal website, <http://www.illinois.gov/taxtribunal/petitions/Pages/default.aspx> , which states that there should be no personal identifiers on any document filed with the Tribunal including Social Security Numbers. That type of information, as well as tax return information not relevant to any issue in the case, may be redacted. This is for future petitions filed with the Tribunal. Nothing needs to be done in the

present case as the Tribunal will redact the personal identifiers on its file copy.
