ORDER

The parties having appeared before the Tribunal today for a pretrial conference, and after a discussion of the facts and issues, it is hereby ORDERED that:

1. The Petitioners' request for leave to file a motion for summary judgment is GRANTED. The Petitioner's motion and supporting memorandum are due on or before March 16, 2015. The Department's response is due on or before April 30, 2015, and the Petitioners' reply, if any, is due on or before May 15, 2015. A date for oral argument, if deemed necessary, will be set after briefing is completed.

2. Exhibit 22, the printout of a "Am I a resident?" section of the Department's website, will not be admitted into evidence, but the parties are free address it, and whatever authority is should be given, in the summary judgment filings as an interpretive document of the Department.

3. Exhibit 29, the letter of September 21, 2011, from realtor John D'Alberti, will not be considered for the purpose of the motion for summary

judgment, as hearsay. But in event the matter goes to a hearing, the parties are free to readdress the issue of its admissibility.
